## **Directions to Astrea Academy Woodfields**

From the North and South:

Access the A1 north or south and take the exit to junction 36. At the roundabout take the first exit into the right hand lane onto Warms worth Road and head straight for 1 mile. Go through five sets of traffic lights and on the sixth set of traffic light get into the right hand lane to turn right onto Hall Flat Lane.

Immediately take your first left turn onto Cross Street and follow the road. This road will merge with Tickhill Road.

Keep on Tickhill road until you reach some traffic lights. Head straight over from these traffic lights onto Weston Road and down to the bottom. Balby Carr will be on the right hand side.

#### From the West:

Access the M62 East and take the exit to junction 33 and head towards A1 South. Take the exit to junction 36 follow the route above in red.

#### From the East:

Access the M62 West and take the exit to junction 35 and head towards M18 South. Take the exit to junction 2 and head towards A1 North. Take the exit to junction 36 and follow the route above in red


