In account of a number of children from Hexthorpe Primary attending the Year 6 Residential Trip and therefore missing the first two Y6 Transition Days at Astrea Academy Woodfields, we have arranged a further day of transition to take place on **Wednesday 5th July 8:30am – 3pm**. This additional, **full day of transition**, is **essential** if students are to make the smoothest possible start to their time at secondary school.

In line with the information provided and itinerary for the 1st Induction Day on Tuesday 11th July, on the morning of **Wednesday 5th July** Y6 scholars should arrive at the academy's Main Entrance (nearest to Main Reception on Weston Road) at **8:30am prompt**, where they will be welcomed by staff. Furthermore, we ask that you support on this day by ensuring they come to the academy prepared in their current school uniform and bring with them a pencil case and a bottle of water. Again, on this day Astrea Academy Woodfields will provide all scholars with a meal at lunch completely free of charge.
